The Scalo House is a newly renovated home located in the Historical District of downtown Madison, IN. Our house is equipped to accommodate eight male residents. The facility is within walking distance of many cultural, recreational, and employment opportunities.

Healing Begins at the Front Door

The Scalo House provides the structure necessary for residents to establish and further strengthen their sobriety. The residents will learn responsibility for maintaining personal sobriety and the necessary living skills which enable them to become increasingly independent. Our objective is to aid the resident's return to society as a functioning member of the community.

Criteria

The Scalo House Admissions Committee in conjunction with the referral source will determine the appropriateness of the admission.

Main Elements

- **AA/NA**
Residents are expected to follow the 12 steps, find a sponsor, and regularly participate in AA/NA meetings and Recovery Dynamics.
- **Education**
Residents will attend various educational sessions.
- **Work/Life Skills**
In order to develop responsibility and renew their self-esteem, residents are expected to find and maintain employment in the community. residents will also help with household chores, cooking, and governing the house.
- **Family Reunification Program**

Residents are expected to pay \$125.00 per week.

The Scalo House includes a full-time Director, and a night House Manager. Curfews are enforced seven days a week.
